This Month's Program – Psychology and the Art of Bonsai

Club member **Andrew Nelson** will again try to tickle your brains with interesting observations about bonsai using science as a starting point. Beginning with a description of the neurological and psychological processes involved in visual perception, Andrew will speculate about how those processes influence human perception and, by extension, the assessment of art. What is actually involved in processing a visual image? Does our intuitive conception of how we see represent what is really going on when we observe something? How are mental processes related to aesthetic judgments? Are the rules of Bonsai unique or do they apply to other artistic endeavors, as well? If you've ever wondered about these or similar issues, come, bring your own ideas, and explore this interesting topic.

Last Month's Program

Jim Barrett brought three junipers and selected one to style and pot. He picked one with some character and presence and created a Kengai (full cascade – with the apex dropping below the bottom of the pot) in a round, but not-too-deep pot. Jim noted that the Japanese generally don't use very deep cascade pots, like those often recommended here in the 'States, even for trees with long downward cascading branches. He styled this tree in the more typical Japanese form with a moderately deep pot and cascading main branch sweeping forward. The potted tree will be in the Club's holiday raffle on December 8th.
