PROGRAM: LEROY KUBEL – REVIEW OF 2010 SHOW AND OTHER EVENTS



For many years now, charter member Leroy Kubel has been taking professional-quality photographs of our annual show and sharing them with the club. His annual presentation has grown to include other events of the previous year, old photos of club members, their trees, and many other surprises, now even set to music on a DVD. LAST MONTH: TED MATSON ON BROOM STYLE



Ted's presentations are always very informative and entertaining. My note-taking pen had a hard time keeping up with him, but here are a few of his points. Ted says there are two types of broom styles: the traditional symmetrical broom style used for elms and zelkovas where all branches emerge from the same location on the trunk at a flat cut, and the more natural "oak" style where not all branches emerge from the same point on the trunk.

A broom style tree has what might be called a martini glass shape with radial flared branches all around the trunk. The lowest branches don't necessarily have to be the largest ones; they may be secondary branches. Let the tree suggest its style. There are wide varieties of styles beyond the traditional shapes.
