### **PROGRAM: ANN ERB AND JOHN KOPP ON OLIVE REPOTTING**

Olives are great trees to grow as bonsai in our area. They are very forgiving of most anything we do to them and are not particularly fussy about soils and watering. They just seem to want to grow no matter what. The warm weather of Summer is the best time to work on Olives. Ann has told us of a radical method of repotting them which facilitates their ability to grow great roots—nebari--in a short time. The method involves literally cutting the old base off the tree and starting from a flat-bottomed rootless trunk. It sounds impossible but Ann says it's foolproof. Come see it happen.

### **LAST MONTH: TED MATSON'S FINAL POMEGRANATE DEMO.**

Ted's unusual twisted seven-trunk pomegranate group that started out as a nine-tree group of saplings at his presentation to our club in April 2006 got its last grooming from his magic Masakuni pruning shears before he donated it to our club. The group is not yet ready for showing but the basic structure is there and the twisted-trunk feature that will make the planting special is starting to become evident. Ted's knowledge of his subject was well displayed during his two-plus hour presentation. Tom Post is presently caring for the tree which will be raffled off at our August potluck.
