PROGRAM: TED MATSON ON BLACK PINES



Japanese Black Pines: Everybody loves them, but it seems that everybody has a different idea on how to treat them, and every year there is at least one new idea on the best way to grow them. For most of us, all these ideas so far have had the same result: very long needles and often yellow ones at that. This month Ted Matson, one of bonsai's leading masters, will present the latest thinking on how best to grow them in Southern California. Ted rarely leads anyone astray, so don't miss his presentation. Ted began studying bonsai in 1979 in San Francisco. He moved to Los Angeles in 1980 where he began a serious pursuit of the art, taking classes from leading masters in Southern California. Today, in addition to his own classes he maintains a busy teaching schedule, traveling to nurseries, clubs, and study groups throughout California and across the U.S.
